There are 5 family members living together with Wenemi. I would like to introduce them to you.

Wenemi and her family's health

Pládichina todi me that Wenem has been in good health during the gast six months. This means that she was one of the formular loses a still, many olther suffer from diseases that could be prevended. Nisiema is currently participating in a growth monitoring program which will help to highlight a possible lack of nutrition and thoe ensure healthy development. If Weneme or any old her family is skit, they can go to the dispensary, a journey of about forty fire minutes. If there were an emergency case, the family would have to travel about two hours to get to the ensert hospital.

Where Wenemi and her family live

Wenemi's family lives in a small house made of unfired mud bricks with an animal manure, mud and clay roch. The house is owned by the family without a legal title. Whilst showing me their home, I pladishinks told me that the house is in a latic condition. Wenemid stamily does not have better own strine and have to use an open field or public area for their needs. This creates a lower level of hygiene and increases the incidence of disease, marticularly amonotit the children.

In many mens of Plan's work a lack of access to deen sale drinking water ell year round is a real problem and can cause an increase in common vater-borne diseases such as damhoes and chollen. Throughout It was Weneren's family get their water from a borehole with a hand pump that is less than Tilm away. There is sufficient water during both rainy and dry seasons. The water is safe for the family to drink at all times. Weneren's family uses an open fire to cosk their draily meals and their main fuel's wood. Collection frewcod is

usually the work of vicence and children and a very time consuming task. For lighting, the house the family uses knowned less than the syst the eight the depress of the syst as the lock of light makes at difficult to who not not household chore in the evening. Weream's family, like their finneds and neighbours have a very small success and it is a struggle to be able to meet the beside. However, the families in the Dargo commonly have a rich social life. During their spear time, Weream's family loves tallong with finneds and laterally to the radio.
